

Gater VST Plugin User Manual.

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Installation :

Decompress the Gater.zip file (Right click, 'Extract All'), then copy or move (or drag) the Gater.dll file into the 'VST Plugins' folder of your host application. This is usually in "\\Program Files\\Steinberg\\Vstplugins"

What Does It Do?

The Gater is a stereo BPM-synchronized 16th note (semi-quaver) rhythmic gate.

GATE BUTTONS

The yellow buttons. Select for each 16th note (semi-quaver) in a bar whether the gate is on or off.

GATE SHAPE DISPLAY

Selects either the sustaining or decaying gate shape by clicking in the display.

RND (Randomize).

The red button. Randomises the gate pattern each time it is clicked.

MIDI :

MIDI controllers (CC) 45 to 61 are mapped to the Gater's controls as follows:

45 : GATE-01	53 : GATE-09	61 : GATE SHAPE
46 : GATE-02	54 : GATE-10	
47 : GATE-03	55 : GATE-11	
48 : GATE-04	56 : GATE-12	
49 : GATE-05	57 : GATE-13	
50 : GATE-06	58 : GATE-14	
51 : GATE-07	59 : GATE-15	
52 : GATE-08	60 : GATE-16	

MIDI reception may not be available with certain VST hosts.
